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Dear Dr. Radwanski:

On behalf of Cherry Murray, thank you for your letter concerning your papers which were submitted to Physical Review Letters and Physical Review B.

The American Physical Society has established procedures of appeals of rejection of papers by the editors of the Physical Review. There is, in these procedures, no role for the President of the Society or any other member of the APS Presidential line. The responsibility for scientific review rests with the editors of the individual journals, and appeals beyond their final decisions are possible only on procedural grounds. The Editor-in-Chief is the ultimate adjudicator of such appeals, but only on the basis of the fairness of the procedures followed.

Since the Editor in Chief has already ruled on these matters there is no further recourse, and Dr. Murray is not in a position to give further consideration.
